Project Description, Justification and Location

This project will replace Ezell Road Bridge where it crosses the CSX Railroad line approximately two miles south of the Chesnee Community. The existing structure is in poor condition with a low load rating of only 2 tons per axle and 3 tons gross. This timber structure is not wide enough to accommodate two vehicles at one time and is one of the lowest structurally rated bridges in the County. CSX has agreed to contribute to the project.



Benefits to Residents, Visitors, Businesses, or County Employees

Replacing this bridge and aligning the new structure with the road will ensure motorist safety, as well as increase the capacity to handle larger vehicles. This bridge accommodates approximately 1,300 vehicles daily.

Impact on Annual Operating Budget

Annual maintenance costs from FY 2010-14 will be minimal.
